The **Community Meeting on 10/12/11** will provide an overview of the recently-completed Historic Resource Survey undertaken by the city as part of the historic district process for Rossmoyne. If you are receiving this notice, it means that you own and/or reside in a property within the proposed district. The survey finds that the area appears to qualify as a potential historic district, but no zone change to create a district will occur without the consent of a majority of property owners and approval of the City Council.

This meeting provides you with the opportunity to ask questions about the potential district and to discuss the Historic Resource Survey. The survey includes a Historic Context that covers the history and development of Rossmoyne as well as individual Survey Forms for each property. The Survey Forms identify character-defining architectural features, construction dates, and indicate your home's status as a potential "contributor" or "non-contributor" to the proposed historic district.

Glendale Planning Department staff will be available to discuss the proposed district and any comments or corrections you have about the survey form for your property. A copy of the Survey Form for your property is included on the back of this notice. Due to the size of the potential district (504 properties), we cannot mail a copy of the Historic Context to each owner and/or resident. Please go to www.ci.glendale.ca.us/planning/hphomepage.asp to review a copy online. A printed copy will also be available in Room 103 of the Municipal Services Building at the address noted above.

The **Historic Preservation Commission Meeting on 10/24/11** will review the survey, which will be edited to include any corrections you provide. Owners, residents, and other interested parties will also be able to share their comments about the survey and the potential historic district with the Commission. If the Commission votes to approve the survey historic district proponents will be authorized to circulate petitions among area homeowners requesting that the city create a historic district in Rossmoyne. If the owners of over 50% of the homes in the proposed district sign the petition, the nomination will move forward in the process, with future hearings before the Historic Preservation and Planning Commissions to be held before the final vote by City Council.
