FARE POLICY

Glendale Beeline's fareboxes accept coins, currency, and Beeline passes, but do not make change and the bus operators carry no cash. Please have exact fare ready.

Metro passes and tokens are not accepted as Beeline fare media.

Beeline buses are equipped with TAP (Transit Access Pass) validator devices. The TAP validator accepts a TAP card with stored value or an EZ transit pass, and an Access Rider ID card. Stored value can only be used to pay a fare. It cannot be used to purchase transfers. Please tap your card on the TAP validator to pay your fare. If the TAP or Access card is rejected by the TAP validator for any reason, passengers must pay the appropriate Beeline cash fare.

Failure to pay the proper fare is a violation of Section 640 Penal Code and may result in a fine up to \$250 and 48 hours community service

Reduced Fare Eligibility

Reduced fares are available for seniors, persons with disabilities, Medicare cardholders and students. Proper identification is required at the time of boarding for all reduced fares.

Seniors

The reduced fare rate for seniors is available to all persons 62 years of age and older. Boarding with the reduced fare requires one of the following photo ID cards: DMV ID Card or Drivers License, Passport, US Permanent Resident Card, or Metro Senior TAP Card.

Disabled

The reduced fare rate is available for persons of any age with a disability. Boarding with the reduced fare requires one of the following photo ID cards having a disabled designation: DMV ID Card, Drivers License, or Metro/LACTOA Disabled TAP Card.

Medicare

The reduced fare rate is available to any Medicare cardholder.

Student Pass Eligibility

A current valid student ID is required at time of purchase for the Student Pass. When asked, students are required to present their current valid student ID along with their pass upon boarding.

FARE POLICY CONTINUED

Beeline & Interagency Transfers

Passengers who take more than one bus to reach their destination, can save money by purchasing a transfer. If you need a transfer, please inform the bus operator upon boarding the bus. The transfer may only be purchased with cash and only one transfer may be purchased per paid full fare. Valid for 2 hours at transfer stops only (locations where two or more buses connect). Transfers may not be used to travel in opposite direction (i.e. Route 3 northbound to southbound or from Route 1 to Route 2).

Other Fare Programs

Access

The reduced fare rate is available for valid Access Rider ID cardholders only. A Personal Care Attendant (PCA) traveling with an Access cardholder must pay the appropriate Beeline fare. Access Rider ID cards that are used in a fraudulent manner will be taken by the bus operator and returned to Access. Please contact Access for questions or concerns regarding your Access Rider ID card.

EZ Transit Pass

The Beeline EZ transit pass rate is available to all persons with a valid EZ transit pass loaded on a TAP card. The EZ transit pass is good for local travel on 24 different public transit agencies throughout the greater Los Angeles region. Passengers who use multiple transit agencies on a regular basis are encouraged to purchase an EZ transit pass or a senior/disabled EZ transit pass available at Metro pass outlets. The EZ transit pass fare rate is available under a countywide agreement and may be rescinded at any time should the countywide agreement be terminated.

Metrolink EZ Transit Pass

The Metrolink EZ transit pass fare rate is available to all Metrolink EZ transit pass/ticket holders. The Metrolink EZ pass must be presented to the bus operator. The Metrolink EZ transit pass fare rate is available under a countywide agreement and may be rescinded at any time should the countywide agreement be terminated.

La Canada Flintridge Free Fare Program

The City of La Canada Flintridge pays the fare for passengers who board the LCF Shuttle Routes 33 and 34, and for passengers who board the Glendale Beeline Route 3 in La Canada Flintridge only.
