*Building Permit Fees*

Building Permit Fees shall be as noted below and shall be based upon the valuation of the work, as determined by the Building Official in accordance with Appendix Chapter 1, Section 108.3 of the building code, unless a specific fee is listed elsewhere in this document.

**ARTICLE IV

*PLAN REVIEW*

When determined as being required by the Building Official, the plan review fee shall be eighty five (85%) percent of the total building permit fee. When determined by the Building Official that the project is unusual, the Building Official may determine a plan review fee based upon an hourly rate of \$91.52 per hour.

In addition to the aforementioned fees, the Building official may require additional charges for plan review required by changes, additions or revisions of approved plans or reports, and for services beyond the initial and second plan reviews due to changes, omissions or errors on the part of the applicant. Additional plan review shall be assessed at a rate of \$91.52 per hour (Minimum charge one hour).

If upon consultation with a permit applicant, the Building Official determines that the services of contract professionals are needed to meet the needs of the applicant with respect to providing building, mechanical, plumbing, electrical or geotechnical plan review services, and the cost incurred by the City for such services exceeds the plan review fee which would otherwise be charged, the Building Official may assess additional fees to recover the full cost incurred by the City for providing of the services rendered.

Re-Inspection Fee assessed under provision of Appendix Chapter 1, section 108.5 shall be assigned when the Building Official determines that work that was requested to be inspected has to been completed, when more than two inspection are required to correct deficiencies noted on a previous inspection, or when an applicant has divided the work for a required inspection into excessive parts; thereby requiring the City to perform extra inspections.

Plumbing Permit Fees

When projects are required by the Building Official to have the plumbing systems reviewed prior to a permit being issued, a plan review fee equal to fifty (50%) percent of the permit fee shall be collected with a minimum charge of \$69.68.

Mechanical Permit Fees

When projects are required by the Building Official to have the mechanical systems reviewed prior to a permit being issued, a plan review fee equal to fifty (50%) percent of the permit fee shall be collected with a minimum charge of \$69.68.

Electrical Permit Fees

When projects are required by the Building Official to have the electrical systems reviewed prior to a permit being used, a plan review fee equal to fifty (50%) percent of the permit fee shall be collected with a minimum charge of \$69.68.

**ARTICLE V  
COMMUNITY SERVICES & PARKS**

All the fees in the Community Services & Parks department are approved by the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission, except for Development Impact Fees. Development Impact Fees are approved by the City Council.

The rates for security guards and insurance are not reflected in this fee schedule for most facilities. These rates are set by a third party vendor. Rates will be determined at the time of rental based on required insurance and security for the event.

**SECTION 1: COMMUNITY CENTER FEES**

The facility fees in this section reflect the "standard" rate charged for a private/non-commercial reservation.

Commercial rentals are charged a facility fee equivalent to 150% of the standard rate (rounded to the nearest whole dollar). The Commercial rate will be assessed when a group meets one or more of the following criteria: the group is charging admission to the event, the group is selling a product or service at the event, or the group is generating any type of revenue from the event or use of the facility. City sponsored groups and activities are exempt from this rate.

The community centers also provide a 25% discount (rounded to the nearest whole dollar) to non-profit organizations who qualify. (The discount does not apply to the miscellaneous fee category, activity cards or insurance rates). Non-profit organizations requesting a discount must provide a Tax ID Number or proof of 501(c)3 and a letter describing the type of organization, type of event and justification for a reduction in rate. The Non-Profit rate must be authorized by the Director of the Community Services & Parks Department.

**SECTION 6: DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES AND APPEALS**

The fees in this section are exempted for Auto Dealers, Hotel Development, Hospitals, Churches, and Schools.

Additional building square footage not exceeding 1,250 will also be exempted from these fees.

Residential Sub dividers may request dedication of land to the City in lieu of paying a Quimby fee when that fee exceeds one million dollars.

A sliding scale discount for covenanted affordable housing projects applies to projects providing affordable housing units on-site as part of the development and is as follows:

- 20% Affordable-100% Exempt
- 15% Affordable-75% Exempt
- 10% Affordable-50% Exempt
- 5% Affordable- 25% Exempt

The sliding scale discount does not apply to projects paying an affordable housing fee in lieu of constructing the units (See *Article IX* for details on the in-lieu fee ).

Such service charges shall be, and not exceed the maximum permitted by the county of Los Angeles general public ambulance rates, as they now exist or as amended, plus all applicable related charges including, but not limited to, consumable supplies. In the event a person receives any emergency medical assessment but is not transported, there shall be a charge reflecting the cost to provide such assessment, but in no event shall the charge be less than one hundred dollars. All charges outlined in Ordinance 5265 and Ordinance 5247 shall be applicable regardless of whether the ambulance dispatched by the city is city-owned, owned by another public agency or commercially owned. Multiple patient service charges shall be prorated when applicable. Please refer to the ordinance for a more details on the service charges.

- Every customer is limited to one Electrical Service Spot per location, there may be a fee associated with any request of revision.

Exceptions

If a residential customer is upgrading an existing overhead or underground service to 100A for safety reasons (room additions to not qualify), the service is installed at no charge.

If a customer is a fire victim and the electrical service needs to be reconstructed and no service upgrade is taking place, the service is installed at no charge.

If the customer is moving the electrical panel or the panel is updated and the service size stays the same, the following applies:

1. OH Services

  - b. If a new service conductor is required, all regular charges apply.
2. UG Services
