



City of Glendale: Addendum to Sidewalk Dining Permit – COVID-19
June 8, 2020

On May 29, 2020, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health announced that restaurants could re-open their dining rooms to accommodate 60 percent capacity. As a way to assist restaurants with the loss of potential indoor capacity due to COVID-19, the City of Glendale launched the Al Fresco Glendale Program.

This Addendum:

- Waives the application of \$233 for 90 days, from June 9, 2020 to August 31, 2020.
- Allows outdoor dining and alcohol service (with ABC license) in City-designated Parklets, or in areas extending along the sidewalk beyond the boundaries of the property, for qualified applications that meet the amended Sidewalk Dining Permit Application requirements.
- Requires adherence to all Los Angeles County Department of Public Health orders.

In addition to filling out the Sidewalk Dining Permit Application, the following information will be required:
