

Maintenance of Trash receptacle Area and Trash Day Do's and Don'ts

- All trash must go in receptacles.
- Area surrounding trash receptacle must be clean at all times.
- Tight fitting lids are required on each receptacle.



Every owner, tenant, occupant or person owning or having the care of any premises shall keep his or her premises in a clean and sanitary condition...See [Glendale Municipal Code \(GMC\) 8.44.190](#).

Each receptacle shall be of the type which does not permit the contents thereof to sift or pass through any openings therein. Each receptacle shall have a tight-fitting lid which secures to the receptacle in such a manner as to prevent as best as practicable the entry therein by coyotes, dogs, cats, rodents or other animals. See [Glendale Municipal Code \(GMC\) 8.44.130\(A\)](#).

- Take out your trash container no earlier than 3:00 PM the day before collection day.
- Place trash container by the curb in front of your home.
- Remove your trash container from the curb no later than 8:00 PM on collection day.
- Trash containers must be stored off the street and outside the front yard area all other days.
