

Temporary Holiday Decorations and Lighting

The City of Glendale prides and encourages its citizens to decorate their properties for the holidays. However, all decorations and lighting are temporary and need to be removed after the holidays.

The City of Glendale's Building and Safety Code, V4.590-3(b), states that temporary electrical lighting installations shall be permitted for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days. This includes temporary holiday decorative lighting and/or similar lighting devices.

The City of Glendale Neighborhood Services Section recommends that all temporary holiday lighting and decorations be put up no earlier than November 1, and promptly be removed by January 31.
