Dryden Apartment Fire

On Tuesday, January 14, 2014 at 2:05 a.m., 9 Glendale units (1 Battalion Chief command team, 5 engine companies, 2 ladder truck companies, and 1 basic life support ambulance) responded to a reported apartment fire located at 417 West Dryden Street in the city of Glendale.

Glendale Truck 26 arrived on scene and discovered a two-story apartment complex with smoke showing from the front of the building. Upon further investigation, firefighters encountered heavy smoke and fire in a single apartment unit on the first floor. The smoke detectors in the unit alerted the residents who self-evacuated the building. Firefighters deployed multiple hose lines and conducted ventilation to extinguish the fire, which was contained to the involved unit. Knock down of the fire was declared at 2:37 a.m., 32 minutes after units were dispatched to the scene.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for three hours and 45 minutes. Structural damage is estimated to be \$75,000, and \$10,000 in damage to contents. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to ensure sprinklers and smoke detectors are working properly.
