Traffic Collision on the Northbound 2 Freeway

(Glendale, CA) On Tuesday, February 4, 2014, 7 Glendale units (1 Battalion command team, 3 engine companies, and 3 basic life support ambulance) were dispatched to a traffic collision on the northbound 2 Freeway south of the Mountain Avenue exit in the city of Glendale.

Glendale Engine 25 was first to arrive on scene and discovered a four vehicle collision. Upon impact, the four vehicles scattered across multiple lanes of the freeway. Glendale firefighters assessed each vehicle and assisted the occupants safely out the vehicles. California Highway Patrol managed the traffic, which backed up to the 134 Freeway.

The Glendale Fire Department paramedics assessed five patients at the scene for injuries. All five patients were transported to local hospitals for further medical evaluation.

Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for 1 hour and 55 minutes. California Highway Patrol is conducting an investigation to determine the cause of the accident. The Glendale Fire Department encourages drivers to take caution when operating a motor vehicle, and be sure to always wear a safety belt.
