Traffic Collision Involving a Motorcycle

On Sunday, April 28, 2013 at 1:04 p.m., Glendale units (1 Engine, and 2 Rescue Ambulances) responded to a traffic collision at 2746 Verdugo Road in the City of Glendale.

Glendale Engine 24 was first to arrive on scene and discovered a motorcycle had collided into a single vehicle. Firefighters found a male victim inside the vehicle. The male motorcycle driver was located on the ground next to the vehicle.

Glendale Fire Department paramedics evaluated both patients. The vehicle occupant sustained minor injuries and the motorcycle driver sustained major injuries. Both patients were quickly transported to local hospitals for further medical treatment.

The cause of the collision is under investigation by the Glendale Police Department. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for 1 hour and 35 minutes.
