**HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE:**

The subject property is a single-family, two-story residence with an attached 2-car garage built in 1936 and located in the Rossmoyne neighborhood. It is designed in the Minimal Traditional style, and its character defining features include the wood shake siding and plaster finish, decorative wood shutters, the single rectangular door, the side-facing gable roof clad with composition shingles, and the shallow eaves with exposed rafter tails. There is also a large brick fireplace. The wood multi-paned casement windows with divided light are all original. The street-facing entrance is also provided with a brick stoop/landing, which leads to a door that has glass panels on the top half. There are also decorative pendants on the underside of the second story ledge, one on each end facing the street.
