Brockmont House Fire

On Tuesday, October 7, 2014 at 8:37a.m., 9 Glendale units (1 Battalion Chief, 5 engine companies, 2 truck companies, and 1 basic life support ambulances) under command of Battalion Chief Bill Lynch responded to a house fire located at 330 Brockmont Drive in the City of Glendale.

Glendale Engine 26 arrived first on the scene to discover smoke showing from the windows of the 3-story hillside home. Firefighters deployed multiple hand lines to the second floor of the home and conducted ventilation operations. The home is located on a narrow street resulting in limited access to the street and water supply. Knock down of the fire was declared at 8:52 a.m., 15 minutes after units were dispatched to the scene.

During the initial search of the home, firefighters located a cat in need of assistance. Fire personnel provided oxygen to the cat and were able to reunite the cat with its owner.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for two hours and 40 minutes. Structural damage estimates are \$200,000 and \$50,000 in damage to contents. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to ensure sprinklers and smoke detectors are working properly.
