Palmer Avenue House Fire

On Thursday, November 20, 2014 at 5:33 p.m., 10 Glendale Fire units (1 Battalion Chief, 5 engine companies, 2 truck companies, 1 air utility, and 1 basic life support ambulance), under the command of Battalion Chief Bill Lynch, responded to a house fire located at 1330 East Palmer Avenue in the City of Glendale.

Glendale Engine 22 arrived first on the scene to discover heavy smoke showing from around the chimney and attic vents of a three-story hillside home. Firefighters deployed multiple hand lines to address the flames located on the second and third floors, while crews conducted ventilation operations on the roof. The home is located in the Adams Hill neighborhood on a narrow street resulting in limited access for the fire apparatus. Knock down of the fire was declared at 6:23 p.m., 50 minutes after units were dispatched to the scene. The two adult occupants of the residence were able to safely exit the home. Firefighters and civilian personnel reported no injuries.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. The Glendale Police Department assisted with traffic control during the incident. Structural damage estimates are \$100,000 and \$20,000 in damage to contents. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to ensure sprinklers and smoke detectors are working properly.
