Vehicle drives into a structure

On Tuesday, December 16, 2014 at 12:39 p.m., 5 Glendale units (1 Battalion Chief, 2 engine companies, 1 truck company and 1 basic life support ambulance) under command of Battalion Chief Bill Lynch responded to a traffic collision located at 2820 Honolulu Avenue in the City of Glendale.

Glendale Truck 29 arrived first on the scene to discover a vehicle into the storefront of a business in a strip mall. Glendale Firefighters ensured all occupants of the business evacuated and assisted with debris removal. City of Glendale Building and Safety Officials were on scene to address the structural integrity of the building. One business was affected by the collision and it will remain closed until repairs can be made.

Glendale Fire Department paramedics assessed the occupant of the vehicle and transported the patient to a local hospital for further medical evaluation. The five occupants of the business were unharmed during the collision.

The cause of the accident is under investigation. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for one hour and 17 minutes. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to be cautious when driving in the rain.
