1040 West Glenoaks Blvd. - Garage Fire

On Thursday, January 8, 2015 at 9:24 p.m., 7 Glendale Fire units (1 Battalion Chief, 2 engine companies, 2 truck companies, 1 air utility and 1 basic life support ambulance), along with one Burbank engine company under the command of Battalion Chief Ron Gulli, responded to an unknown fire located at 1040 West Glenoaks Blvd. in the City of Glendale.

Burbank engine 11 arrived first on the scene to discover a detached garage fully engulfed in flames. Burbank and Glendale firefighters quickly began attacking the fire with multiple hose lines. Glendale firefighters also conducted roof top ventilation to assist with the fire attack.. Knock down of the fire was declared at 9:43 p.m., 19 minutes after units were dispatched to the scene.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for two hours and 52 minutes. Structural damage estimates are \$75,000 and \$25,000 in damage to contents. The Glendale Police Department assisted with traffic control during the incident. The Glendale Water and Power department was on scene to address the possibility of damaged power lines.

The Glendale Fire Department encourages apartment owners to ensure sprinklers and smoke detectors are working properly.
