South Brand Two-Vehicle Traffic Collision

On Tuesday, January 13, 2015 at 1:08 a.m., 4 Glendale units (1 Battalion Chief, 1 engine company, 1 truck company and 1 basic life support ambulance) under the command of Battalion Chief Bill Lynch responded to a traffic collision located at the intersection of South Brand and Los Feliz Road in the City of Glendale.

Glendale Engine 22 arrived first on the scene to discover a two-vehicle collision in the intersection of South Brand and Los Feliz Road. After the collision, one of the vehicles fled the scene because they were involved in a police pursuit. The other vehicle had two occupants. Firefighters had to extricate one of the occupants using the specialized hydraulic tools while the other occupant was able to self-extricate.

Glendale Fire Department paramedics assessed the two occupants of one of the vehicles at the scene. One patient was transported to the hospital for further medical evaluation. The other patient was released at the scene. Glendale police officers apprehended the two suspects about two blocks away from the scene. Glendale paramedics provided medical attention to one suspect prior to being taken into custody.

The Glendale Police Department is investigating the collision. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for one hour and 15 minutes. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to be cautious when driving and always wear a safety belt.
