Monte Vista Appliance Fire

On Monday, April 13, 2015 at 2:34 p.m., 9 Glendale units (1 Battalion Chief Command Team, 4 engine companies, 2 ladder truck companies, 1 air utility unit, and 1 basic life support ambulance) along with one Burbank engine company under the direction of Battalion Chief Thomas Marchant responded to a reported appliance fire located at 538 Monte Vista Avenue in the city of Glendale.

Engine 26 arrived on scene and discovered a single-family dwelling with smoke showing from the front left corner of the home. Upon further investigation, firefighters located the fire in the laundry room, which extended into kitchen. Firefighters deployed multiple hand line hoses and conducted ventilation to extinguish the fire. Knock down of the fire was declared at 3:04 p.m., 30 minutes after units were dispatched to the scene.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for two hours and 21 minutes. Structural damage is estimated to be \$50,000, and \$10,000 in damage to contents. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to ensure sprinklers and smoke detectors are working properly.
