**CASE DESCRIPTION**

**The appellant is requesting that the Planning Commission overturn the decision of the Community Development Department to grant an exemption under Glendale Municipal Code (GMC) 8.36.290(K) (noise ordinance).**

**ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW:** Exempt from environmental review per State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15303, Class 3 "Existing Facilities" and 15305 Class 5 "Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations".

The Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing in Room 105 of the Municipal Services Building, 633 East Broadway, Glendale, on **May 18, 2016**, at 5:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible.

The hearing will be in accord with Glendale Municipal Code Section 8.36. The purpose of the hearing is to take public testimony regarding the subject of this appeal.

"Acknowledged" shall mean a declaration of property ownership (or occupant if not owner) under penalty of perjury. If you challenge the decision in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Glendale, at or prior to the public hearing. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, please notify the Community Development Department at least 48 hours in advance (or two business days) for requests regarding sign language translation and Braille transcription services.
