Rescue on Westbound 134 Freeway

On Tuesday, August 16, 2016 at 7:10 a.m., five Glendale units (One Battalion Chief Command Team, two engine companies, one ladder truck company, and one basic life support ambulance) under the direction of Battalion Chief Thomas Marchant, responded to a reported freeway rescue on the westbound 134 freeway at San Fernando Road in the City of Glendale.

Engine 26 arrived on scene and discovered a three-vehicle traffic collision on the westbound side of the 134 freeway. One of the vehicles landed on top of the k-rail center divider. Firefighters extricated two patients from the vehicles involved in the accident.

Glendale Fire Department Paramedics assessed two patients at the scene, both of whom were not injured.

The cause of the collision is under investigation. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for 48 minutes.
