North Isabel Structure Fire

On Sunday, October 9, 2016 at 1:37 p.m., nine Glendale units (One Battalion Chief Command Team, five engine companies, two ladder truck companies, and one basic life support ambulance) along with one Burbank Battalion Chief under the direction of Battalion Chief Thomas Marchant, responded to a reported structure fire located at 720 North Isabel Street in the City of Glendale.

Engine 26 arrived on scene and discovered flames showing from a single apartment in a two-story garden style apartment building with subterranean parking. Upon further investigation, the fire was located in the garage of the involved unit. Firefighters also encountered heavy smoke throughout the two-story apartment unit above the garage. Residents were evacuated from the involved unit and the neighboring unit. Firefighters quickly deployed multiple hose lines to extinguish the fire and conducted ventilation to clear the heat and smoke from the structure. Knock down of the fire was declared at 1:55 p.m., 18 minutes after units were dispatched to the scene.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. There were no injuries sustained during this incident. The fire was contained to the involved unit. The estimated cost of structural damage was \$30,000 and damage to contents was estimated to be \$20,000. The Glendale Fire Department encourages residents to ensure sprinklers and smoke detectors are working properly on a regular basis. Glendale Fire Department resources were on scene for two hours.
