



# VERDUGO FIRE COMMUNICATIONS

## SYSTEM PAGING TEXT FORMAT

Rev 09-14-17

The Verdugo Computer Aided Dispatch System (CAD) has the functionality to *automatically* send call information via text message (SMS) to cell phones or an e-mail address. These text pages will be sent based on Alarm Level or incident group type (e.g. structure fires, heavy rescues, brush responses, etc.)

Shown below is a screen shot of an incident page sent to a smart phone:

The following is the description of the information contained in the text page shown above:

- A. **Verdugo** = Sender
- B. **09/14/17 08:55:10** = Date and time incident was *dispatched*
- C. **1** = Alarm level
- D. **ELECF** = Type code (type of incident)
- E. **534 S Oak Knoll Av #305, PAS** = Incident location
- F. **Btwn E Del Mar Bl & E California Bl** = Low and high cross streets
- G. **R3** = Tactical channel assignment (RED3)
- H. **566\_6A** = Thomas Bros Map book coordinates
- I. **VFC17063198** = Verdugo incident number (VFC #)
- J. **Smells something burning inside condo** = Additional incident text
- K. **Stop** = End of text message
