Administrative Design Review No. PDR 1818522 Pending Decision

The Director of Community Development will render a final decision on or after **May 2, 2019** for the following project:

The applicant is proposing to add a total of 1,601 square-foot, two-story addition at the rear of an existing 1,649 square-foot two-story office building (built in 1931), located on a 5,533 square-foot lot in C1 (Neighborhood Commercial) Zone. The existing site's parking lot will be restriped to provide nine (9) parking spaces in compliance with the Zoning Code requirement.
