PEOPLE & PETS

Your loved ones & pets are your most precious belongings. Ensuring their safety isn't just a matter of knowing where they are in an emergency, but also in helping them understand what to do. After all, you may not be together when disaster strikes. A Family Communication Plan can help you safely reunite.

PRESCRIPTIONS

Maintain a file containing all of your prescriptions and doses. Other evacuation necessities include medicine and medical equipment, vision and hearing aids, and batteries and power cords.

PAPERS

Copies of insurance information, important phone numbers, Identification cards, financial and Legal Documents.

PERSONAL NEEDS

3 days' worth of basic survival supplies: Water, food, clothing, cash, first aid kits, phones, and chargers.

Additionally, if you have loved ones with disabilities, make sure their immediate needs are also covered.

PRICELESS ITEMS

While a cherished family picture may not be critical to your survival, our connections with these things are part of what makes us human- include them in your evacuation plan.
