This includes:

- **Going on a walk**
- **Picking up essential goods**
- **Walking your pet**



What is a face covering?

A face covering is not the same thing as a mask. A face covering is a material that covers the nose and mouth. It can be secured to the head with ties or straps or simply wrapped around the lower face. It can be made of cotton, silk, or linen. A cloth face covering may be factory-made or sewn by hand, or can be improvised from household items such as scarfs, T-shirts, sweatshirts, or towels. **Glendaleca.gov**
