

**Glendale Youth Alliance  
Annual Report of Activities and Outcomes  
2008-09 Program Year**

The Mission of the Glendale Youth Alliance (GYA) is to promote, facilitate, and provide employment opportunities for Glendale youth ages 14-21. Since its incorporation in 1993, GYA has provided employment and training to over 4,500 youth. For more information about the programs, please visit our website at [www.glendaleyouthalliance.com](http://www.glendaleyouthalliance.com)

**Summer Youth Employment Program  
240 Youth Employed**

Youth Participants between the ages of 14-24 receive life skills, pre-employment training and paid work experience. The Brush Clearance Program provides the youngest and unskilled youth ages 14-16 a first time job experience. On closely supervised teams, they spend six weeks removing overgrown brush on over 30 parcels of City-owned land, augmenting the City's Vegetation Management Program and reducing the risk of fire on the City's hillside. Youth who already possess some basic job skills are placed in jobs in the community such as the local hospitals, nonprofit organizations, libraries, schools, and public agencies. This program is funded by the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act and City of Glendale Departments.

**Glendale Youth Employment Partnership - GYEP  
40 Youth Employed**

Youth that succeed in the Summer Brush Clearance Program, are eligible to participate in GYEP. In this self-sustaining program, supervised teams of youth ages 14 to 18 are hired to perform hillside brush clearance on private properties for a fee. Youth can also be hired for other general labor tasks.

**Glendale's Resource for Employment and Training - GREAT  
21 Youth Employed**

In this program, youth with a proven work ethic and previous job experience are placed in career exploration jobs. Their wages are paid by the business that hires them.

**Training, Employment & Mentoring Program - TEAM  
57 Youth Employed**

The TEAM program is designed for youth who are able to work more independently. Participants learn to meet workplace expectations such as being on time, dressing appropriately, and following through on assignments. Funding is provided by Workforce Investment Act (WIA). The TEAM program is funded by the Verdugo Workforce Investment Board (WIA) and is a year-round program. The participants in this program are students who are currently high school seniors.

**Employment Incentive Program  
51 Youth Employed**

The Employment Incentive Program serves older youth ages 18-21. Youth are placed primarily in private businesses to gain the skills and experience needed to climb the career ladder within a company. The program pays for the initial training hours as an incentive for the employer to hire the youth. Funding for this program is provided by Workforce Investment Act (WIA).

**Hospitality Training Program  
47 Youth Served**

Youth ages 17-24 who are interested in career ladder jobs within the hospitality industry receive training and employment to succeed in this service sector. Youth are placed in entry-level positions to gain first hand work experience and concurrently partake in "30 Ways to Shine as a New Employee" training provided by Los Angeles Community College. The funding for this program is provided United Way.

**Boy Scout Explorer Post # 604  
64 Youth Served**

The Post provides GYEP youth with leadership training and experience, as well as supervised educational and recreational activities.

Other events include the first Armenian American Women in Business Excellence Annual Luncheon which honors Armenian American women who have been exemplary businesswomen and devoted community activists. This luncheon not only serves to celebrate the tremendous professional and personal successes of these phenomenal women, but also highlights the importance of community service. Furthermore AACC has and continues in organizing Small Business Workshops, job fair, as well as conferences focusing on business both in U.S and Armenia like the recent conference in the city of Long Beach titled "Doing Business with Armenia".

As a non-profit AACC has participated in many charitable programs, including outreach to different non-profits as well as youth scholarships awards and educational scholarships for different colleges, universities and the first Armenian American Fire Fighters scholarship

Recently AACC expanded its services by forming new chapters. Currently there are several chapters of AACC including the Greater Los Angeles, Little Armenia (Hollywood) and Washington Chapter.



## Friend of Youth Award: Patricia S. Ryan / GUSD

Professionally, Patricia Ryan graduated from CSUN college and immediately was hired to work in the school district from which she earned her K – 12 education – Glendale Unified. During several years in the classroom teaching English and home economics, Pat discovered a special success in relating and working with high risk students. Some years later, after earning her master's degree in Counseling and Guidance, Pat was hired to work as the counselor for at risk students at Glendale High School in the Alternative Education program. Parents frequently remarked that their children in the program benefited from the close relationships with their teachers and with their counselor. That lasted for three years.

Pat continued at Glendale High for another nine years in several counseling capacities working with all levels of student populations. While all levels – college prep, gifted, average and high risk – provided immense reward as an educator, Pat found that her heart was always with that high risk student who with a positive adult connection could be successful and achieve their goals. This past school year 2008/2009, Pat was given the opportunity to move to Allan F. Daily Continuation High School where she is able to focus her counseling skills on the kinds of kids she feels especially devoted to. In addition, Pat volunteers weekly, and has for the past 13 years, with the ACTION Family Counseling – Parent and Teen Support program. As a coordinator of this group in Glendale she has the opportunity to work with parents and teens having difficulties with poor teen behavior, truancy, drugs, alcohol and anger management.

Personally, Pat is married and has three adult children and one grandchild. In her off time she likes to take Harley Davidson bike trips through the states with her husband and friends, go boating, read, watch movies and cook.



## Founder's Award: Robert McFall



Bob was born and raised in Southern California, coming from Temple City, California, and attended the San Gabriel School District.

While attending college at the California State Polytechnic University in Pomona, Bob first worked for the City of Glendale from 1973 until 1975 as an Administrative Intern in the Parks and Recreation Division. He obtained his Bachelor of Science Degree in Parks Administration in 1975.

After graduation, Bob briefly worked for the Claremont Men's College and the City of Downey, returning to Glendale in 1977 as the City of Glendale's Park Superintendent. He continued in this position until 1986 when he became the Director of Parks and Recreation. While in Parks and Recreation, he was instrumental

in founding the Pacific Southwest Maintenance Management School, taught at Glendale Community College and began his career-long involvement of volunteering with community organizations.

Expressing an interest in moving into general government, Bob was recruited for his current position of Assistant City Manager in 1987. In this capacity, Bob serves as the Chief Operating Officer of the City and oversees the general operations of all fifteen City departments. Bob is involved in all aspects of the City's employee relations program, serves as the Administrative Hearing Officer for personnel grievances and appeals, and serves as a trainer in the Glendale University program. Additionally, Bob supervises the City's Internal Audit Unit, Community Relations Program local cable broadcast unit and the City's major capital improvement projects. He coordinates the annual budget process and facilitates special organizational studies, and is liaison to other community and government agencies. In a word, Bob simply loves the role he has been able to play and feels blessed with his career in Glendale.

Bob serves on a variety of Community Boards and is involved in a number of volunteer efforts, currently including the Glendale Chamber of Commerce, Glendale Educational Foundation, PATH Homeless Center – where he is also a “guest chef” each month, the Relay for Life, the Glendale Character and Ethics project, and Glendale Human Relations Committee. He serves as an instructor for Leadership Glendale, and earlier in his career with the City, Bob was involved in the annual Pasadena Tournament of Roses Parade, including driving the Glendale rose float for eight years. He uses his photography hobby to often serve as the “unofficial photographer” for various community events.

Bob is married to the beautiful Patty and together they have four children. He has recently become a grandfather to Jedidiah, with a second grandchild on the way. Both of Bob's children went through the Glendale School system and are actively engaged in their careers.


## **Haik Hairapetian – Fiscal Credit Union**
