## **NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY**

### **CONSTRUCTION OF BICYCLE FACILITIES (MEASURE R) AND CITYWIDE BIKEWAY AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Dear Resident and/or Property/Business Owner:

The City of Glendale's Public Works Department has retained our company to make certain traffic and street improvements in your neighborhood as part of the Construction of Bicycle Facilities (Measure R) and Citywide Bikeway and Pedestrian Improvements Project. The duration of the entire project is approximately **80** working days for various locations on the attached project location map. The construction work is scheduled to begin April 2016 and is expected to be completed by October 2016, barring unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions.

The following improvements are scheduled to be completed at the various locations:

- Installation of Class II Colored Bikeway with Bike Lane signing and Bike Lane pavement markings;
- Installation of Class III Bikeway with Bike Route signing and Shared Roadway pavement markings;
- Installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB);
- Installation of Wayfinding Signs;
- Application of crack seal, slurry seal, and Asphalt Rubber Aggregate Membrane (ARAM); and,
- Construction of Portland Cement Concrete ADA curb ramps.

Our company is committed to working with you to help alleviate the impact of the construction on your daily activities. Every effort will be made to minimize any inconveniences to you. If you need to drive through the construction zone, please allow additional commuting time.

We are responsible for sequencing and scheduling the work. We will post a door hanger that targets the day we expect to be in your neighborhood barring unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions. We will also post "NO PARKING" signs in the work zone 24-hours in advance of working on your street.

Unfortunately, the project is sometimes delayed in which case, the previous days work may not be finished and construction activity will resume the next working day. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the City of Glendale.
