
CONSTRUCTION OF BICYCLE FACILITIES (MEASURE R) AND CITYWIDE BIKEWAY AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The City of Glendale's Public Works Department has retained our company to make certain traffic and street improvements in your neighborhood as part of the Construction of Bicycle Facilities (Measure R) and Citywide Bikeway and Pedestrian Improvements Project.

To achieve this, the work will typically involve:

- Installation of Class II Colored Bikeway with Bike Lane signing and Bike Lane pavement markings;
- Installation of Class III Bikeway with Bike Route signing and Shared Roadway pavement markings;
- Installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB);
- Installation of Wayfinding Signs;
- Application of crack seal, slurry seal, and Asphalt Rubber Aggregate Membrane (ARAM); and,
- Construction of Portland Cement Concrete ADA curb ramps.

It is anticipated that the entire work will be completed within 80 working day(s) and hope that it does not cause undue hardship.
